CONSTITUTION

January 24, 2021

Article I. Name

The name of this club shall be the SOUTH CENTRAL RADIO CLUB, hereinafter referred to in this document as The Club or SCRC.

Article II. Purpose

Section A. The purpose of the club is to:

- 1. Promote interest in operation and experimentation on all amateur frequency bands as authorized by the Federal Communication Commission for amateur radio services, General Mobile Radio Service bands as authorized by the Federal Communication Commission, and all other aspects of radio use.
- 2. Encourage the spirit of fraternalism among the members of the club and to assist them in obtaining the full benefit of radio.
- 3. Encourage the growth and expansion of radio.
- 4. Provide appropriate club sponsored forums, events and activities which aid in the education and the intellectual growth of club members.
- 5. Give and render aid to the public at large as in time of need without pecuniary gain.
- 6. Engage in those activities, as authorized by the Federal Communication Commission and under the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, to fund club operations, events and activities, as well as to provide for the accumulation of assets necessary to promote club activities and the other above state purposed.
- 7. No part of the assets of this club shall be the property of the members or any of them, but such assets and income shall be devoted exclusively to the purpose of the club.

Article III. Membership

Section A.

- 1. Membership in the club shall be open to all individuals without regard to sex, race, creed, color, or national origin.
- 2. Qualifications of Membership in the club shall be specified in the By-Laws.

Article IV. Officers

Section A.

1. The officers of the club shall consist of a President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, and various Trustees.

2. Qualification, methods of election, nominations, terms of office, removal from office, duties and responsibilities, indemnification, and other related matters pertaining to the officers of the club shall be specified in the By-Laws.

Article V. Meetings

Section A.

- 1. The annual meeting shall be held during the month of December.
- 2. All matters pertaining to the frequency, time and place of club meetings shall be specified in the By-Laws.

Article VI. Amendments

Section A.

- 1. Changes may be made to this Constitution when it is deemed necessary that the interests and welfare of the club could be furthered by changes to this Constitution.
- 2. Amendments to this Constitution may be made at a regular meeting or at a special meeting called for the purpose of making and adopting changes to the Constitution.
- 3. An amendment must be presented in writing to the Secretary of the club and to the membership, either in writing or by oral means for consideration at least one (1) month in advance prior to the regular or special meeting called for the purpose of voting on the amendment.
- 4. All voting members of the club must be notified in writing of the place, date and time of the vote to amend the club's Constitution at least 30 days in advance of the vote.
- 5. A two-thirds (2/3rds) majority, present at the designated meeting for voting on the amendment shall be necessary for the adoption of the amendment.

Article VII. Dissolution

Section A

1. In the event of dissolution of the club and pursuant to the non-profit laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and after settlement of all claims, debts and expenses of dissolution, all remaining assets and funds shall be distributed to another like organization, which is organized and operated exclusively for education and scientific purposes in accordance with Article II, Section A of the constitution and one that has established it's tax exempt status under the rules of the Internal Revenue Code.
